

Tech Rider / Staging Guidelines

Following the guidelines below will help make your event a massive success. If anything is too much trouble feel free to contact me to work out a plan.

Stage and Layout:

1. Stage area should be flat, level and at least 10 feet wide by 8 feet deep. (bigger is better).
2. I should have a plain background with no mirrors, nor people behind me.
3. Audience should start as close to stage area as possible (no orchestra pits between us please)
- 4. Audience must NOT be eating during the show! (This is very important!)**
5. If the show is in a theater, it's best to have all stage lights at 100% and house lights at 50%.

When I'm driving to you

1. I will provide all sound equipment.
2. A close parking space will help things run smoothly

When I'm flying to you

1. Car from airport should be a towncar or bigger to fit my equipment.
2. My room should be a single non-smoking room, ideally next to the elevator.
3. Will need a high quality PA that will accept 1/4 inch, 1/8 inch or XLR signal. (If you need recommendations, just ask).
